NCCI Item E-1410 – Revisions to NCCI Manual Rules Related to the Inclusion of COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Claims in Experience Rating and Merit Rating.

Pursuant to ch. 626, Wis. Stat., the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance has approved the following change adopted by the Governing Board. The Extraordinary Loss Event (ELE) Catastrophe Number 12 for the reporting of COVID-19 claims expires as of June 30, 2023.
