Bernard Rosauer convened the meeting with the following Anti-Trust statement still in effect from the Annual meeting:

“This Committee meeting has been called to discuss the items of mutual interest and concern to the members of the Wisconsin Compensation Rating Bureau. In accordance with both Federal and Wisconsin State Anti-trust Laws, this Committee is prohibited from any discussion or action which constitutes any form of boycott, coercion, or intimidation.”

A Special Rating Committee meeting was called to discuss the October 1, 2026 rate filing. The following items were discussed:

- Trend factors recommended by the Actuarial Subcommittee.
- An overall decrease in rate level of 1.97%.
- No change to the current Expense Constant of \$220.
- No change to the current Maximum Minimum Premium of \$900.

The Governing Board and Rating Committee accepted the recommendation for filing with the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance.
